1. Discussion Item(s)

a. Open Discussion for public comments

b. Board update

The board approved the Pickleball and the new golf solar contract. April has been one of the worst security months. Bill asked the mayor for help in this issue and he was able to provide some significant assistance. This was also the first case where the camera program was helpful in bringing them to justice. It was a band of bad kids that were repeat offenders about 6 of them. Fines are basically about \$1000. The POA is looking at hiring as many as 3 "event" officers to improve security during summer and at the pump track. They may consider renting a golf cart for transportation. Tony brought up tht the RFID is typically not working at the Pump Track gate. Rich asked if there is a ranking or certification process, currently there are road patrol officers and supervisors, the POA is thinking about de-escalation training for the patrol_

This can be sent to the board for the May meeting. Jeff made a motion to send this into the board and Darryl seconded the motion.
