Parking Lot Pavement Project

This was a large-scale \$3.4 million project that encompassed repaving 15 parking lots and a portion of Canyon Lake Drive North. Many of the parking lots were over 50 years old and badly deteriorated. The new, improved parking lots feature retaining walls, planters, ADA walkways, and ramps. Parking lots and areas that were renovated include Blue Bird Hall, Canyon Lake Golf & Country Club, Canyon Lake Lodge, Diamond Point Park, Eastport Park, Equestrian Center Driveway Entrance, Gault Field, Holiday Harbor Park, Indian Beach, Moonstone Beach, North Ski East & West, Operations Yard, Senior Center, Sierra Park, and Canyon Lake Drive North (from Vacation Drive to Goetz Road).



AUGUST 2019

The Board approved funding for the Parking Lot Pavement Project at the August 6, 2019 Regular Session Board Meeting. The approved funding amount was \$3,425,000 from the Road Reserve Fund to cover the repavement of 15 parking lots and a portion of Canyon Lake Drive North.



OCTOBER 2019

The Country Club parking lot repavement was completed in October 2019. The new parking lot was reconfigured with a more efficient layout with accessible parking near the entrance. New decorative stamped concrete was added to the Country Club entry and drive circle. New LED parking lot lights were also installed.

NOVEMBER 2020

The last part of this project, the Canyon Lake Lodge parking lot renovation, was completed in November 2020. This was one of the most significant parts of this project, and it was split into five different phases. The parking lot was completely reconfigured to add additional parking spaces. Additionally, an ADA walking path leading to the boat docks was added.
