The player sees his ball move and calls a penalty on himself while his caddie and his opponents try to convince him that the ball didn't move. He says it moved "I saw it move" and takes a penalty. This is the kind of integrity that we should have on and off the course.

2022 USGA rules for Handicap reporting

The game of Golf is the only game that relies on each golfer to maintain the integrity of the game by honest and fair play as well as the accurate and timeliness of posting scores. What follows are the current handicap rules for posting per the USGA. After you review these rules if you have any questions please reach out to me for clarification.

Each round of golf must be posted by midnight of the day the round is played. This new rule is driven by the change that handicaps are being updated daily. (Rule 5.4 of Handicapping). After one warning of noncompliance the player will be subject to a penalty round. The penalty round will be posted as the lowest round a player has had over the last 20 rounds.

-To post an 18 hole round the player must complete at least 14 holes. Any holes not played after 14 must be posted as net par. If a player completes less than 14 holes but more than 9 a nine hole round should be posted. (Rule 2.2 of Handicapping)

-To post a 9 hole round the player must complete 7 holes. Any holes not completed should be posted as net par. (Rule 2.2 of Handicapping.

-Rounds played by yourself cannot be posted. A peer review must take place to confirm or challenge the score being posted. (Rule 2.1 of Handicapping)

-The maximum score for each hole is limited to net double bogey. (Rule 3.1 of Handicapping) -For a score to be posted each score card submitted must be signed and attested. Noncompliance with be subject to disqualification during club tournaments. Without a properly completed score card any tournament questions or challenges cannot be addressed. We have had several instances where improperly submitted scores cards voided a valid rules challenge or dispute. Please get in the habit of always completing the score card correctly so it becomes second nature.

Hope this information helps in all of us ensuring the continuing integrity of the game. Thanks.




