

The clubs are broken down into 3 & 4 team playing groups. 16 player teams then compete head-to-head in a home and away matches. The teams winning their groups advance to a single elimination tournament ending with one Champion. Canyon Lake has both a Thursday and a Saturday Team.

As an amateur, team play the closest you can get to playing in a Ryder Cup. It may sound silly - but that is the best way I can describe it. The individual match, team match, and representation of your club and community – if you have competitive juices – Team Play will get them flowing. If you think your game is up to the challenge – sign up for team play.

#### Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.


#### Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2 Value A: 24.3 + 12 = 36.3 | Value B: 16.2 + 12 = 28.2

A / B: 36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128 Improvement factor: 1.128

#### Canyon Lake Men's Golf Club Completes First Major Tournament of the Year!

The 2023 Spring Kickoff found 90 members, over a third of the CLMGC membership, playing in a two-tournaments in one format. Those interested in representing the Men's Golf Club in the SCGA 4-Ball Tournament competed in one tournament and those interested in a Member/Member format in a second tournament.

In the **4-Ball Tournament**, "A" Flight was won by Tournament Chair Jesse Beecher and his partner Derek Jones with a two-day score of 14 under 128, beating the second-place team of Jon Evans and Dan Rawlins by two strokes. Tom Faia and Marcus Schonabaum were three strokes back, finishing in third place. In "B" Flight, Mike Golovich and Robert Scott convincingly won their flight by six strokes with a 13 under 129. Chasing Mike and Robert were Carl Garlichs and John Giambra at 136 and Van Meredith and Corky Wyrick at 135. Winning "C" Flight by eight strokes were Jason Bader and Victor Flores with a 17 under score of 125 that was the lowest of the tournament. Jason and Victor will represent the Men's Golf Club in the SCGA 4-Ball Tournament. Chris Poland and Clive Taylor had a 17 under score of 125 to win the Member/Member Tournament by four strokes over second place Tom Hirsch and David Kelley, with Guy Loomer and Steve Viotti one stroke further back in third place. 
