Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example

Starting Handicap Index: $24.3 \mid$ Ending Handicap Index: $16.2 \lor$ Value A: $24.3 + 12 = 36.3 \mid$ Value B: $16.2 + 12 = 28.2 \mid$

Happenings in the Past from your CLMGC Historian:

30 years ago, May 1993 ~ May was Member Guest tournament month as it is 30 years later. Current members Bob Stinson, Tom Fuhrman and Bob Krause all played in the tournament 30 years ago.

The Saturday Team Play team were among the final four teams in the SCGA playoffs being held during the month of May. Current members Hugh Wagoner, Tom Fuhrman, Bob Stinson, Greg Leathley and Shannon Van Druff were members of the team. These guys are like Die Hard Batteries, they just keep on going. Collin McCaffery's dad John was the team captain. There were 150 teams at the start of play in January. The Canyon Lake team made it all the way to the finals and lost the championship to Balboa Park who won the Championship for the third year in a row. Second out of 150 teams is pretty darn good.

The TWG was busy working on the lake project on hole #13. A dam was being built, creating an upper and lower lake, a bridge to the #14 tee was under construction and the installation of railroad ties around the perimeter of the lake were all under way. Most of us just take the lake for granted, but it wasn't there until 30 years ago. It was 30 years ago that the first sand party to fill divots was held. The CLMGC donated \$200 to purchase seed that was mixed with the sand. That tradition continues on today.

20 Years ago, May 2003 ~ The Men's Golf Club membership totaled 427 and the oldest member was 93 years old and the youngest was Rob Decker, 34, who recently returned to membership in the Club. I guess that makes him 54 now. Welcome back Rob. Current member Fred Hemborg was the Membership Director. The Canyon Lake Association of Past Presidents (CLAPPS) purchased 26 trees with proceeds from the Beautification Tournament and they were planted left of the cart path along hole #18. Your historian remembers this project. Take a look 20 years later at this improvement to the course. Hopefully this years Beautification Tournament will allow for a lasting project on the golf course as it did 20 years ago. The Spring Kick-off Member/Member tournament was held the previous month and the winners were Greg Leathley and Hugh Wagoner who represented the CLMGC in the SCGA Net 4-Ball Championship. Greg and Hugh are still active members to this day.

The Canyon Lake Women's Golf Club Hosted a "Springtime in Paradise" Jack and Jill Tournament. The winners are no longer members or residents of Canyon Lake, Bill Stevenson and Jackie Robertson. But the second, third and fourth place winners, Jeannette Williams and Tom Fuhrman, Judy and Dudley Thompson and Sue and Gary Sell are still active in our tournaments.




Aggressive Tire (cart path only)
