Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2 Value A: 24.3 + 12 = 36.3 | Value B: 16.2 + 12 = 28.2 A / B: 36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128 Improvement factor: 1.128

Men's Golf Club Golf Sponsorships for Kids in Canyon Lake

Back in 2020, President Barry Talbot and his Board set aside \$1000 for Junior Golf Scholarships. While its utilization was slowed by the pandemic, the money was used to sponsor young Canyon Lake Golfers at various regional tournaments. The 2023 Board finished awarding the funds after announcing their availablility and then sponsored two golfers.



Tegan Perry is an 8 year old junior golfer living in Canyon Lake who plays in about 20 tournaments a year. Tegan responded to the Men's Club offer and in 2023 we provided a \$283 sponsorship for his entry fees in the 6 tournament season of the US Kids Fall Tour. Tegan had some up and down scores throughout the 6 tournament season with some great learning experiences along the way. After that season was completed, Tegan finished in 5th place out of 18 golfers in his age group. He has now moved up into the 9 year old age group. Tegan is a member of the Canyon Lake PGA Junior League and participates in weekly group lessons.

Reed Williams is a 13 year old golfer living in Canyon Lake with an active yearround tournament schedule. Reed responded to the Men's Club offer, and we provided a \$345 sponsorship for tournaments at the Indian Hills Golf Club, the Via Verde Country Club and the Willowick Golf Course. He shot a 93 at Indian Hills placing 6th out of 11. At Via Verde, he shot a 93 and placed 7th out of 11. Reed has been playing golf for over 8 years and takes lessons weekly from our resident pro Pat Kimball. He participates regularly in the US Kids Golf tournaments in our area.



Junior Golfers in Canyon Lake have a variety of opportunities to improve their skills. We have a chapter of the PGA's Junior League with about 15 active members. David Seymour leads an outstanding Junior Golf Academy that provides weekly instruction to groups of 6 kids or less

Meet your two new Directors ~

Larry Mensch ~ Secretary: Larry and his wife Barbara returned to Canyon Lake in 2023 after an eleven-year absence, living in Discovery Bay, CA. Prior to leaving in 2012, both Larry and Barbara were very active in the Canyon Lake golf community, serving as presidents of their respective golf clubs.

Larry was born in Pennsylvania and moved to Ontario, CA in 1955 when he was eleven years old. After graduation from college, he started teaching as a volunteer with the Peace Corps in Sierra Leone, West Africa from 1967-1969. Living through a "military coup" in Sierra Leone he returned to the United States and started teaching Junior High in Gonzales, CA while earning a Master's Degree at San Jose State. This led to a 32-year career with the Oak Grove School District in San Jose as a Jr. High Science teacher, Counselor, Vice Principal and Elementary School Principal. Larry was on an interview panel for counselors when he met his wife, interviewed her (she got the job), and later proposed to her and they have been married for 40 years.

Larry and Barbara raised three sons in San Jose and enjoyed "a great deal of water activities in the Discovery Bay area where they spent summer vacations before buying a home there seven years before retirement and their first move to Canyon Lake.

Larry didn't take up golf until he retired in 2003. He says "we'd play in the afternoon, so as to not hold up anyone". In addition to golf, Larry and Barbara enjoy "RVing" and are members of the Canyon Lake Roadrunners. Larry says "We are glad to be back in Canyon Lake". We're glad to have him back and serving on the board.

Joe Wood ~ Social Director: Joe is a native southern Californian, born in South Gate, CA and raised in Compton and Downey. After graduation from Downey High School in Downey, Joe joined the US Army and served from 1966-69. During his time in the Army he was stationed in Texas, Oklahoma, Viet Nam and Germany. While serving in Viet Nam in 1967, during the "Tet Offensive", his unit came under a heavy mortar and rocket attack and he ran across an open field to save two of his fellow soldiers. His efforts were successful and he received a field promotion to Staff Sergeant and was awarded the Bronze Star for saving two lives. Joe says that "many men died during this time and I was proud to serve and feel that I was motivated and protected by God to return home".

After his time in the military, Joe started his working career as a Fireman/Paramedic with the Costa Mesa Fire Department from 1972-1980. Making a drastic career change in 1980, he became a mortgage banker with Shearson/American Express until 1992. Another career change came in 1992 when he opened J/K Excavation and Grading that he owned and operated until his retirement in 2014.


